

HARVARD ID CARDS FOR STUDENTS AND SCHOLARS

To gain access to most Harvard facilities you must show your Harvard photo ID card.

STUDENTS

Students receive their ID cards during their schools' registration times. For registration times and locations being held at your school, consult your school's registration materials or its web site.

You will be able to pick up your ID card only after your department has processed your Harvard appointment form, so it may be a good idea to check with your department to be sure that your forms have been processed before going to have your picture taken.

REPLACEMENT CARDS FOR STUDENTS AND SCHOLARS

If you lose your ID card, you may obtain a replacement card from Identification and Data Services Central Office (see above for location). Students and scholars will be charged \$20.00 for the first two replacement cards, and \$40.00 thereafter.

ID CARDS FOR ATHLETIC FACILITIES

Harvard's athletic facilities are available for recreational use by all members of the Harvard community. College and GSAS students gain access to facilities by displaying their valid Harvard ID cards. All other students and all scholars must purchase participation stickers that vary in cost according to the school. You may purchase stickers on-line with a Harvard ID and PIN (personal identification number). However, family memberships must be purchased at the Athletics Department, Murr Center, 65 North Harvard Street, Boston. Hours are Monday - Friday, 9 am - 5 pm.
